REVISED August 13, 2024 -- Net use instructions:

- 1. There are two courts. Only one is configured for both tennis and pickleball.
- 2. The "Tennis Only" court has the net set at regulation height. The center net strap is set to 36" tennis height and prevents "whipping" and damage in windy conditions. The strap should not be readjusted and should always remain hooked down.
- 3. The Tennis/Pickleball court utilizes one center net strap to set the net at 36" tennis height and a second strap to set the net at 34" pickleball height. To play tennis or pickleball switch the center net strap hook to the desired strap (pickleball strap is labeled). The straps should not be readjusted. *Please* keep one strap hooked down at all times to prevent damage to the net.
